

Cooperation between Stations and Analysts, Status and Future

To get the best SLR products a close cooperation between tracking stations and analysts, under the guidance of the ILRS is essential. The ILRS has set up some mechanisms to qualify the stations on the one side and to benchmark the analysis groups on the other. The daily range bias reports or the weekly station position solutions are examples how analysts could help the stations to provide better and unbiased tracking data. If we consider a possible daily production of SLR products, a closer and eventually direct cooperation between the analysts and stations for an immediate feedback is desirable.
